***Vaccinations**

All vaccinations must be up-to-date.

For Dogs:

- DHPP
- Leptospirosis
- Bordetella
- Rabies (Primary) - Formal certificate with veterinarian signature required
- Rabies (Booster) - Formal certificate with veterinarian signature required

For Cats:

- FVRCP
- Rabies (Primary)
- Rabies (Booster)

FAVN Test: This is **REQUIRED** for all animals unless from a recognized rabies-free area (Hawaii, Guam, Japan). FAVN tests should only be performed at CDC approved laboratories (<https://www.cdc.gov/importation/dogs/approved-labs.html>).

We recommend taking this test 30 or more days after the animal's second rabies vaccine for the best results.

- FAVN results must be greater than 1.0 IU/mL.
- On the FAVN documentation, please list destination as "CNMI".
- If originating from INTERNATIONAL (non-U.S.) and non rabies-free area, **120 days must pass** from date of FAVN blood draw to enter the CNMI.

Parasite Treatment

- Proof of treatment for both internal and external parasites within 14 days of arrival is mandatory.

Itinerary

- Attach a complete travel itinerary.
- Please note any layovers in foreign countries

Payment

On-Island: Pay \$25 at the CNMI Treasury, Capitol Hill, and deposit into account DC005 (Animal Health).

Off-Island: Pay \$25 via cashier's check or money order.
For expedited processing, send a photo of the check.

Health Certificate

The health certificate must include:

1. Confirmation that the animal has been treated to remove internal parasites (helminths and heartworms) and external parasites (fleas and ticks) within 14 days of arrival.
2. The date of parasite treatment.
3. The name of the product(s) used and the method of application.
4. Certification by the issuing veterinarian verifying the accuracy of the information on the health certificate.
5. The microchip number and the date of implantation.
6. The name, serial or lot number, expiration date, and date of rabies vaccination.

*Special Note for INTERNATIONAL Imports

- The CDC has created new regulations requiring additional documents for pets originating in foreign countries.
- All documentation provided must be official veterinary documents in English

DOGS:

- Must be at least 6 months of age
- Have ISO-compatible microchip
- Be accompanied by a CDC Dog Import Form which is submitted online (www.cdc.gov)

ALL originating in non rabies-free area:

- Must wait **120 days** from date of FAVN blood draw before importing animal.

Special Note for RABIES-FREE Imports (Guam, Hawaii, Japan)

- Still must receive TWO rabies vaccines with official signed certificates.
- Must be accompanied by a Certificate of Origin from the veterinarian, testifying that the pet has been residing in a rabies-free area for at least 6 months.
- FAVN is not required. **HOWEVER**, if you plan to return the pet to the rabies-free area, we suggest you get the FAVN drawn before coming to the CNMI as it is not easily accessible here.
