REWARD

Federal, CNMI and Guam officials are investigating the poaching of the fanihi, and a reward of up to \$1,000 is being offered by the Federal government for information leading to the arrest and/or conviction of the person or persons responsible. Anyone with information about the illegal killing and sale of fruit bats is asked to call the US Fish and Wildlife Service's law enforcement office at either (670) 233-0938 or (671) 647-6067. You may also call the US Attorney's Office in Saipan at (670) 236-2980.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- Please do not kill or eat the fanihi.
- Help protect fanihi colonies by reporting any illegal activities that affect the animals and their habitat.
- Volunteer with your local natural resource agency to help protect the fanihi.
