REGULATED SPECIES HUNTERS REPORT CARDS: If you are applying for a hunting/fishing license for a regulated species, such as sambar deer, coconut crab, sea crab, land crab, wild goat/cow/pig, Philippine Turtle Dove, etc., you must **ask** for a hunters report card. You must also submit your hunters report card within fifteen (15) days after the end of the hunting season, or the expiration of your permit. Failure to submit a hunters report card will result in denial of future hunting/fishing/licenses for one complete year.

I understand that if I do not submit my hunters report card fifteen days after season ends, I will be denied any and all future hunting/fishing permit for one year.

IMPORT/SCIENTIFIC: I agree to abide by § 85-30.1-505 (a) it shall be unlawful to release any fish, game, or wildlife species not native (found historically) to the CNMI. The only exception is for species introduced in Division Conservation programs. (b) [Persons responsible for illegal or accidental introductions are liable for the cost or eradication, including but not limited to personal salaries, transportation and equipment.]
