## CNMI FISH FACT SHEET

**Scientific Name:** *Chanos chanos*. Chanos chanos is the only species listed in the Chanidae family; this genus is characterized by having fins without spines.

**Common Name:** Milkfish

Maximum size: 180cm standard length

Maximum age: 15 years

**Lifehistory:** *C. chanos* is said to reach sexual maturity in 5years. Spawning occurs in seawater near coral reefs during new or full moon phases. Milkfish are heterosexual fish. Determining gender through morphological differences has not been established.

Habitat: Reef and mangrove associated; marine; depth range 1-30 meters

Distribution: tropical pacific, Indo-pacific, recorded in the CNMI.

**Diet:** Juveniles feed mainly on diatoms, benthic cyanobacteria, small crustaceans and nematodes. Adults are herbivorous but also feed on zooplankton.

The Chamorro name for *Chanos chanos* is **Agua.**
